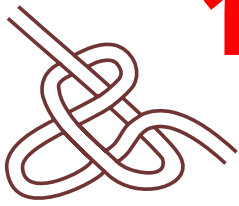
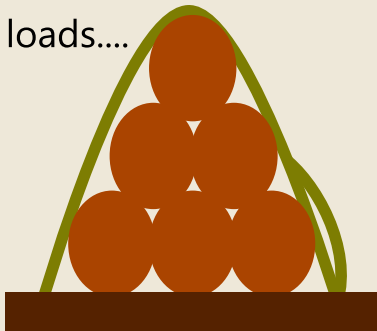


Trucker's Hitch

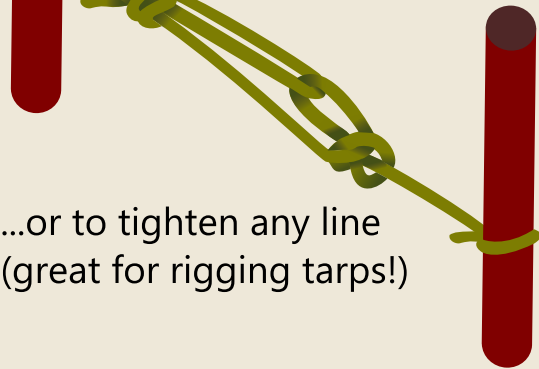


1 The trucker's hitch is a compound knot that begins by forming a loop with a marlin-spike hitch.

Use to secure loads...



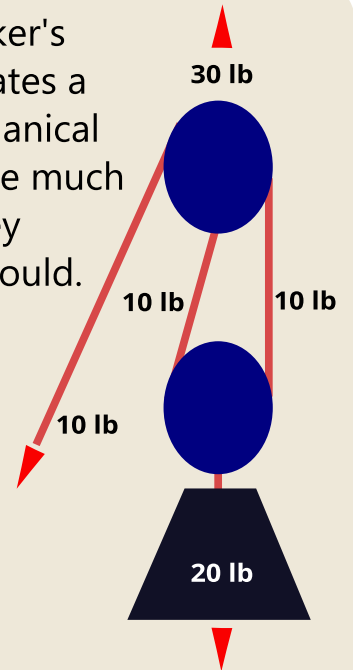
...or to tighten any line
(great for rigging tarps!)



3 Pulling on the line draws up the hitch securing a load or bundle.

4 Once tightened the end of the line is secured with a couple of half hitches.

The Trucker's hitch creates a 3-1 mechanical advantage much as a pulley system would.



2 The line is then led around an anchor point and back through the loop.
